School Uniform Update

You may be aware that the government asked schools to review their uniform policy to make sure costs were reasonable to ensure parents and carers get the best value for money.

We want to assure you that the decision has been strategically and methodically thought through, with all members of our community in mind. We want our uniform to reflect the 'Pride and Progress' we as a school have been focusing on and striving for in recent years. A well thought out school uniform can play an important role in creating an inclusive school community and fostering a sense of belonging. In line with this, the new uniform will be comfortable, smart, practical and affordable.

As from **4th September 2023** it is essential that all children wear the correct uniform. The only changes are a sweatshirt with the most current school logo and a white polo shirt. We are extremely proud of the high standards and expectations at our academy and expect all students to take pride in their uniform and appearance, including their PE kit. The Erdington Hall Primary School PE Uniform consists of:

- Plain white t-shirt
- School sweatshirt or sweatshirt cardigan with Erdington Hall Logo is allowed for PE
- Black tracksuit bottoms/joggers
- Black Shorts (in summer)
- Plain black trainers or plimsolls
- A plain navy blue hijab, this must be of the fitted jersey type for health and safety reasons for PE
- Children in years 3, 4, 5, and 6 will take part in swimming lessons for part of the year. For this, a towel and swimsuit / trunks will be required.

Please note:

- All items of clothing and shoes must be labelled with pupils' names.
- Pupils should attend school in an appropriate PE kit on the days in which they are due to have PE.
