
What have our learners been doing? Here are some snippets from their learning so far...

We have been learning to share the small building blocks and developing the muscles in our funky fingers.


















Year 4 are learning about our bodies this term in project, we had an exciting introduction where we focused on the types of teeth and their uses.















Year 3 have been working hard on developing their Maths skills.

Superstar assemblies



Each week we celebrate our superstars in school, which includes our staff as well as children. We are really proud of our children and the fantastic start they have made to the year.

As well as celebrating the super learning and behaviour in school, we celebrate attendance too. Each week a raffle for children with **90% or more attendance** takes place, where one child receives a **£5**Wonde voucher. At the end of each term, we have three prizes to celebrate the term's attendance.

Clubs

- Clubs have begun and are well underway. After school, there are sports clubs for Key Stages 1 and 2.
- At lunchtimes, there is Fun Club in the library each day and some children are taking part in Art club. More activities will be added to the playground through the term. Please talk to your child about what they enjoy and how they can help look after all the items that they have out on the playground.
- This half term, Mrs Downes will be holding a lunchtime club for Reading/Drama. This will be for **Year Five and Six** children. The children will be able to sign up with their teacher and the club will take place on Monday lunchtimes.

Attendance

- Well done to all of our children who are in school every day they possibly can be. This includes being on time. Remember that 8:30am is the time they can arrive and the latest time they should arrive by is 8:45am.
- If your child needs to go to the dentist or doctor, please make sure that you request an appointment that is not during the school day. If your child attends a doctor or dentist's appointment that is not an emergency, their absence may not be authorised. Please note that proof of appointment needs to be seen by our office staff.
- Term time holidays are **NOT** allowed. Taking a holiday during term time could result in your child losing their school place. Please make sure that you attend every day possible to give your child the best opportunity for achieving well now and for their future.
- We understand that at times our children can become ill and will not be well enough to attend school. But please be aware that if attendance drops below 90%, we will contact you via text each Friday. Please do not be alarmed by this, it is necessary that we make you aware. We can work with you to support you in your children being in as often as possible.

- How can we help one another? **Thank you to parents / carers who call on the first day of your child being absent**. This is a requirement and helpful so that we know how your child is when they will return to school.
- Our EWO (Education Welfare Officer) is Savita Rai. She works with us each week to support families with attendance. Mrs Rai and Mrs Petkar, our pastoral lead, may call on you at home if your child is not in school. Again, please do not be alarmed by this, it is school's responsibility to ensure that we check on our children when they are not in school.
- If there are any worries or concerns, we will try to help you. We work with all of our families to ensure that we can offer the best support possible. Please contact the school office if you require support.

Harvest 2023

- Thank you for those parents who have already donated for this year's harvest. Our focus this year is old uniform and any perishables you can donate. This is tinned or dried food.

School uniform

Start of day and hometime arrangements

At the start of the day

Children can come to school via Ryland Road or Bracebridge Road. The Bracebridge Road is an entrance for children only. Parents and carers must not walk through the school site to a different entrance. This is in place so that we can safeguard our children.

If you wish to speak to a teacher in the morning, this is not possible as they are dealing with their classes. If there is something urgent, please telephone the school office or tell the member of staff on duty at the entrance you use.

Hometime

We have revised how our children leave at home time. In Reception, it will remain the same. In Year 1 and 2, the children will leave through the hall and line up on their playground. For Key Stage 2, children will line up together in and between the MUGAs. This ensures safety for all and hopefully a speedy dismissal.

Please help your child and school to do this safely by standing away from, and in front of the lines so that staff can see you. Thank you to all you who do this as it is much safer for all our children. Please do not approach the teacher during this time as they need to focus on making sure that the children leave as quickly as possible. If you do wish to speak to a teacher, please wait until the children are all dismissed. If you cannot wait or do not collect them, please do not hesitate to call the school office and arrange a time to speak to them.

Behaviour around school

So many of our children are showing excellent behaviour around school and are receiving plenty of praise for this as well as Dojos when they are exceptionally good. Keep it up everybody!

Thank you to all of you who model excellent behaviour to your child and to others. It helps to keep our school a safe and friendly place to be. Where there is behaviour of any adult entering our school site that is not acceptable, please be assured that this will not be tolerated. We have a code of conduct policy for all and will apply this if anyone fails to follow it. We always work with you and any problems that arise are dealt with by our staff team.
