In Reading, we will be learning about:



- Fluency—reading without the need to segment and blend
- Prosody—using a story telling voice when reading, using expression and a varying tone of voice
- Comprehension—understanding what we have read and answering questions using retrieval, inference and prediction skills.

In Maths, we will be learning about:

Multiplication and Division

- Doubling and halving
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Sharing objects and amounts to support in division
- Grouping objects and amounts to support in multiplication.

Subtraction

- Subtracting one-digit numbers
- Subtracting a one-digit number from a two-digit number.

Numbers and the Number System

- Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.

In Writing, we will be learning about:

- Writing a fairy tale:
 - We will be writing in the 3rd person, the past tense, using adjectives for description, and using a variety of sentence openers.
- Writing a letter:
 - We will write a letter from the perspective of a character the children will know well. We will use these to practise our sentence demarcation and composition skills alongside using noun phrases and conjunctions.

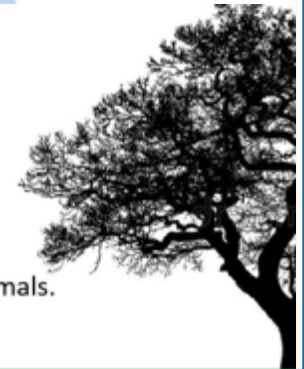



Our curriculum project is: Enchanted Woodland
