Dear Parent or Carer,

Consultation on increasing the Published Admission Number (PAN) of Erdington Hall Primary School

In order to enable more children to benefit from the high levels of education and care on offer at our academies, we are proposing an expansion of our PAN from a single form entry to a two-form entry from September 2026.

We do not intend to make any amendments to our current admissions arrangements; we are simply proposing the return to the previous number of school places offered at Erdington Hall Primary.

Erdington Hall Primary is proposing to increase the PAN from 30 to 60 pupils for (reception) admissions. This would be implemented annually over the next 7 years starting in September 2026, where choices would be made by 31 January 2026 by families.

Consultation begins on Tuesday 3 December 2024 and the deadline for responses to the consultation is Thursday 16 January 2025.

Erdington Hall is a Good provider, which has an excellent curriculum and extra-curricular offer in place. The school is popular, and we would like more families to benefit from being granted their first-choice school in the local area with minimal commute time.

Summit Learning Trust is made up of three secondary schools, five primary schools and a sixth form college educating 8000 learners. All of our academies are located in the Birmingham and Solihull areas which allows us to work closely together for the benefit of all our children, young people and the communities we serve.

The proposal will allow us to accommodate more learners in order for them to benefit from the great education and care offered at Erdington Hall Primary School.

The proposal is to increase our overall PAN from Reception to Year 6 from 270 to 420 (one/two form entry back to two form entry)
