In Maths, we will be learning about:

Exploring Time

- Tell the time to the hour
- Tell the time to half past the hour
- Draw hands on a clock face to show time to the hour and half past the hour
- Solve simple problem involving time

Exploring Money

- Recognise the notes: £5 and £10
- Read and say amounts of money using the notes £5 and £10
- Solve simple problems involving money

Measuring Space

- Measure length and mass using appropriate equipment.

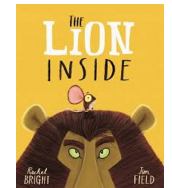
In writing we will be learning about:

Writing a diary entry:

- **We will be writing in the first person, the past tense, using noun phrases and using a variety of punctuations.**

Writing a narrative:

- **We will be showing off all the skills we've built across Year 1 in our final narrative piece! Our new Year 2 teacher can't wait to see our writing.**



In Reading, we will be learning about:

- Fluency—reading without the need to segment and blend
- Prosody—using a story telling voice when reading, using expression and a varying tone of voice
- Comprehension—understanding what we have read and answering questions using



Our curriculum project is: Fossils

Our main subject will be focusing on is: History

We will be learning about:

Artefacts and sources. Noticing and ordering. Fossil and their formation. Immersion in Marry Anning. Questions about artefacts. Critique historical source— info about dinosaurs. Timeline of dinosaurs.



In Art, we will be:

- Exploring textiles
- Learning weaving, threading, knotting and plaiting techniques to create a unique piece of art.

In phonics, we are learning:

- Recap Phase 5 sounds.
- Introduce new alternative sounds in Phase 5
- Learn Phase 5 tricky words

In Music, we will be learning about:

- Controlling pitch
- Moving to the pulse
- Changing tempo
- Learning new songs




In P.E., we will be learning about:

- Team building
- Athletics
- Gymnastics


In P.S.H.E / R.H.E , we will be learning about:

Relationships

This will help support children in learning how to be good friends to others and how to show kindness in their families. It will also help them to become better at building friendships.



In RE we will be learning about being fair and just. We will learn different stories and practices (from different religions) and how they teach believers to be fair and just to others.
