### In Reading, we will be using these skills:

In this unit, children will read *The Wild Robot*, a brilliant story about a robot learning to survive in the wild. They'll build fluency by reading aloud accurately and smoothly, and by revisiting key sections to grow confidence. Vocabulary work will focus on root words, prefixes, suffixes and tricky exception words, helping children understand new words in context. In comprehension, they'll identify main ideas, ask questions, make predictions and draw inferences about characters' feelings and motives. They'll also explore how language, structure and presentation create meaning. Children may also enjoy watching the animated version at home and comparing it to the book.

### In Maths, we will be learning about:

#### Mental recall:

Adding a three-digit number and a one-digit number. Subtracting a one-digit number from a three-digit number.

#### Shapes

Exploring 2D and 3D shapes

#### Angles and Turns

Recognising different types of angles (acute, right and obtuse)

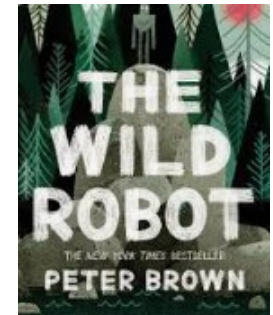
Understanding turns

#### Time

Reading and telling the time using 12hr and 24hr clocks.

### In Writing, we will be learning about:

In writing, children will be utilising their reading unit and will write a first person narrative from the perspective of Roz, the main character. They'll explore what first person means and practise writing as if they are Roz, using her thoughts and feelings. In our writing, the children will be taught to use instruction, notice the effect of short versus longer sentences, and compare the purpose of different sentence lengths. They'll also notice the job of conjunctions and understand how because, so and when work in a sentence.



### Our curriculum project is:

*Mighty Metals* is an engaging cross-curricular unit that explores the scientific properties and everyday uses of metals. Pupils investigate forces and magnets, discover the characteristics of different metals, and explore how they're used in the world around them.

Our outdoor P.E. the focus will continue to be on athletic skills (running, jumping and throwing)

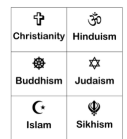
**In P.S.H.E. / R.H.E. , we will be learning about**
