Project

Our curriculum project is: Summer Fun!

The main subject we will be focusing on is: Understanding the World

Children will be able to understand the concept of different seasonal weather changes. We will also be looking at what clothing is appropriate for specific weather and we will explore ice cream parlours and even make our own ice lollies. We will also be focusing on transition into reception too.

Maths

In maths this half term we will be focusing on:

- Counting up to 5, and ensuring we touch each item when we say a number and showing number to 5 on fingers.
- Creating ABAB patterns
- Matching items, sorting items and beginning to compare items. For example: all items are underpants however, some



may be stripy or spotty.

English

In English this half term we will be focusing on Early Literacy Skills such as:

- Writing in different positions e.g. paper on the floor, paper on the wall etc.
- Recognising and writing own name.
Please use name card provide for your child, which demonstrates correct formation.
- Using scissors appropriately to support the fine motor movement in order to then focus on holding a pencil correctly.

We will be learning about:

- Knowing the names of different seasons
- Develop an understanding that the weather changes
- Knowing what clothing is appropriate for which season
